

Ealing Play Service

The Play Service aims to combine care and education in a safe and stimulating play environment to encourage all aspects of a child's development. The Play Service offers a wide range of services including:

After School Clubs - Providing childcare and play for children across 15 local schools in the borough.

Children Centre's - Offering, full time childcare and children's activities all year round.

Play Centres - Activity-based centres that all have outside play areas. Most operate on a drop in basis and are free of charge to the public.

Many of these services are open all year round providing fun activities and learning opportunities for children aged 0 – 13 years.

Holiday Childcare Play Schemes

In addition, the Play Service operates a number of very popular play schemes that run from 8.30am to 5.45pm. These schemes are available to children aged 5 - 12 in locations across the borough and are Ofsted registered with qualified staff.

Places are booked using the play scheme application form, which can be downloaded from www.ealing.gov.uk or requested from the office.
