Reference is made to the EYFS Profile scores and related evidence under 'Knowledge and Understanding of the World'.					
Adult focused and adult initiated activities are based upon the learning objectives set out in the QCA Schemes of Work Units 1A to 1F.					
Planned ICT activities are adapted to provide practical, interesting and motivating first hand experiences.					
Cross-curricular links suggested in the Scheme of Work, QCA units are used to support different aspects of children's learning in other subjects.					
Activities are planned and structured to provide opportunities for Year 1 children to talk, discuss and collaborate in pairs and in-groups.					
The children are able to explore and investigate ICT resources within the indoor and outdoor learning environment during adult directed and adult initiated activities.

A range of ICT resources are available for the children's use e.g. digital cameras/video, tape recorder, tills, telephones for use in role play etc.					
Where alternative units or activities have been introduced to take account of new technologies, teachers plan with specific learning objectives. E.g. in the use of digital cameras / video / computer microscopes / floor & table robots / talking books etc.					
ICT resources are easily accessible.					
Teachers ensure appropriate software is in use for the learning objectives and the children's interests and needs.					
The PC's are ergonomically correct for all children.					
Teachers record pupils' use of ICT and assess their capability against the expectations listed on the QCA Scheme units and National Curriculum Level Descriptors.
