



NCMA Childminding Networks

You may be wondering 'what is an NCMA Children Come First childminding network?'.....

A National Childminding Association (NCMA) Children Come First childminding network is an approved formal group of registered childminders who are assessed, recruited and monitored by a dedicated network coordinator.

The coordinator:

- Assesses and regularly monitors the practice of all the network childminders to nationally approved standards set out in the NCMA Quality Childminding Charter.
- Ensures that the childminders receive appropriate training to develop their skills
- Provides a link between parent and childminder
- Operates a toy library and equipment loan scheme

An NCMA Children Come First childminding network enables quality assured childminders to provide a high quality care and education service to families for all children from birth to 14 years. These networks will be linked into the Children's Centres.
